Hein explained that he had invited Chief Splivalo to attend the meeting to discuss possible alternatives for providing law enforcement services to the Town of Sheboygan. Hein decided to keep the meeting in open session. The Board discussed what they are looking for as far as traffic, parking, and crime enforcement. The discussion of staffing and administrative needs was discussed as well as legal counsel. Chief Splivalo will work on a proposal for the Villiage of Kohler and the Town of Sheboygan Board.
