The Town Hall will be closed the following days:



SNOW PLOW RULES

Snow Emergencies: If a snow emergency is declared, it will be posted on our website and local media will be notified. There is no parking on any Town roads at anytime during a snow emergency.

Snow Plow Markers: Snow plow markers are NOT allowed within two feet of the pavements edge. Markers within two feet of the pavement will be removed!

Please stay back 500' from the snow plows! They are unable to see you due to the blowing snow!

Do not shovel or blow snow into the road: Per WI State Statutes, it is illegal to place snow in the roadway when cleaning your driveway. Please be courteous and help keep our roads clear!

Garbage containers must stay in your driveway: Please do not put your garbage containers in the road. They can be plowed off and you can be fined for having items in the roadway. Thanks for your help!



Dog Licenses expire December 31 of each year. Licenses obtained after March 31 will be charged a \$20 late fee in addition to the license fee of \$10 for neutered or spayed dogs and \$20 for unaltered dogs. You must bring a Rabies Certificate in order to obtain a dog license. Remember-as a pet owner you have the responsibility to license, have vaccinated, keep control and pick-up after your pet. Failure to do any of the above is a violation of State and Local laws and is subject to fines.



Drop Box-There is a drop box located at the bottom of the ramp in front of the Town Hall. **You are encouraged to use this drop box for any correspondence or payments for the Town, Sanitary District #2 or Sanitary District #3.** This is a secure location and is emptied daily.

*** **Diggers Hotline**-Call 8-1-1 or www.call811.com **BEFORE YOU DIG**. This service is free of charge. The Hotline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year. If you have an emergency dial 911.

*** **Free notary** service is available to Town residents during regular office hours. Bring your Driver's License along to verify your signature and do not sign the document ahead of time.

*** **Parking on Town Roads**-There is no overnight parking allowed on any Town Roads between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Fines start at \$25 per violation and double if not paid within 10 days.

*** **Disposal of Sharps** -You may dispose of sharps in rigid puncture resistant containers with secure screw top lids or caps, such as heavy plastic laundry detergent or bleach containers. The nearest collection/drop box to the Town of Sheboygan is St. Nicholas Hospital by the emergency entrance. Unused medication can be dropped off at any of the 5 police stations in Sheboygan County.

REMINDERS

- The State of Wisconsin now requires you to show a photo ID for absentee and in-person voting. Please have your photo ID ready when you come to vote.
- Statewide voter registration is required at all polling places. If you are not registered you may do so prior to election day at the Town Hall. Proof of residency is required. You do not need to re-register if you are already registered.
- There is no voting on the Monday before ANY election in the State of Wisconsin.
- Skip the lines! In-person absentee voting takes place at the Town Hall for approximately three weeks prior to each election. Please bring a valid photo ID.

POLLWORKERS NEEDED - APPLY TODAY!



GARBAGE & RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS MUST be placed in your driveway, **NOT** in the roadway. **CONTAINERS** in the roadway can be plowed off the roadway and you can be ticketed for having items in the roadway per State Statutes. It is YOUR responsibility to pay to replace any damaged containers.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP

Town-wide Christmas tree pick-up will take place on **Wednesday, January 8th, 2020 and Wednesday, January 15th, 2020**, weather permitting or the next available day. Please have your trees out to the road edge by 7:00 am on those dates. You do not need to call the Town Hall to schedule tree pick-up. Please remove all decorations and lights and remember that trees in plastic bags will NOT be accepted.



Scotty Landscape is the residential drop-off site for residents of the Town of Sheboygan. Yard waste is accepted for FREE. Visit our website at townofsheboygan.org and click on Drop-off Site for the complete list of what is accepted and the cost to bring it to Scotty. The list also includes what is not accepted and hours for summer, fall and winter.

Park Rental

Fireman's Park is available for reservations for your special event. Rates are \$100 for Town residents and \$200 for non-residents. There is also a refundable \$50 deposit if the Park area is cleaned up after your rental. You must make your reservation in-person at the Town Hall. 2020 reservations are available beginning January 6, 2020 at 7:00 a.m. The park rental permit is on our website under Forms.
